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PROGRAM ADVISORY COMMITTEES TERMS OF REFERENCE

- 1. Program Advisory Committees will be established by each School/Department through a Dean/Director appointment for all applied programs as well as other program areas that would benefit from formal linkages to the community with the purpose of:
 - a) advising the College on program outcomes, skills required of the graduate, and on program development, review and renewal;
 - b) advising the College on current trends in the field; and
 - c) providing a valuable link to our community.
- 2. The Program Advisory Committee will be chaired by a member of the committee who will be elected annually by the members.
- 3. Program Advisory Committees will normally meet twice annually but may meet more frequently during times of new program development or major changes to programs.
- 4. Members will be appointed for a term of up to two years with a provision for renewal.
- 5. All PAC's should have a comprehensive spectrum of field expertise that includes
 - a) employers of grads that reflect the diversity of industry or the field of study
 - b) licensing and accreditation bodies
 - c) representatives of professional associations
 - d) alumni working in the field and, as appropriate,
 - e) organized labour, destination institutions, government, and sponsoring agencies, and
 - f) social service and community agencies.
- 6. College employees are welcome to attend PAC meetings to hear the discussion and receive advice.
